Can medical students in Saskatoon have 24/7 access to the Health Sciences Building?	The Health Sciences Building is unlocked daily from 6:00 a.m. - 11:00 p.m., exclusive of statutory holidays and university closure. During these times the HSB can be accessed through the Royal University Hospital. Can subsidized bus passes be made available to medical students in Regina?	This is being investigated, but we feel confident that yes, bus passes can be secured.
Can medical students in Saskatoon have better access to parking on campus?	Effective August 1 there will be 65 parking spots for the Stadium Parkade for 3rd year students. Parking will be available year round. More information on cost and process for securing one of the spots will be sent to the current 2nd year students in the near future. Additionally students can access the health region shuttle for clinical sessions at St. Paul's Hospital and Saskatoon City Hospital.
