If you think your research may have potential for commercialization or should be patented why don't you make an appointment to sit down with a Technology Transfer Officer? They can do a search for you to see if your idea has already been patented or not (not only in Canada but all around the world) and market your technology to industry.

The Industry Liaison Office is responsible for the commercialization of research and knowledge developed by the University's researchers, faculty, staff and graduate students. Their focus is to foster and develop collaborative work environments among researchers, industry partners and funding agencies.
