

WRITTEN PERSONAL STATEMENT

1. How has your lived experience shaped your identity, and how will this impact or influence your role and practice as a physician in Saskatchewan?

Instructions for personal statement creation and submission:

- Your response must be no longer than 750 words (maximum).
- Your response must be in 12-point Times New Roman font.
- Your response must be double spaced.
- Your response must have 1" x 1" margins.
- **Do not put** your name, application number or student number anywhere in your submission. The PDF document should be titled LASTNAMEEDDDMMYYYYPersonalStatement (i.e., SMITH01JAN2025PersonalStatement).
- The above question must be clearly identified at the start of your response.
- The personal statement **MUST** be uploaded as a **single** PDF document.
- A personal statement that is not submitted as per the formatting instructions **may not** be considered.
- The **deadline** to submit the written personal statement is **October 15, 2025 at 11:59 pm CST (Saskatchewan time)**. A late submission **will not** be considered.
- Once the personal statement is uploaded as a supplemental item, no further changes will be permitted.
- Applicants may be asked to further speak to their written personal statement during the application cycle and may be asked to identify a verifier (or verifiers) who can speak to the authenticity of their written personal statement at any time during the application cycle.
