Criterion 1: Evidence of leadership, for example, through:

- Committee or other volunteer roles (local, provincial, national or international)
- Peer recognition (awards, invited presentations, lectures, workshops)
- Feedback from colleagues and/or learners re: nominee's effectiveness in making change or leading innovation

Criterion 2: Evidence of achievements, for example, through:

- Record of peer reviewed scholarship
- Impact on local and/or external programs, units, institutions, etc.
- Commitment to advocacy
- Community impact

Criterion 3: Evidence of a caring approach

building a healthy workplace, teams, and citizens, such as (but not limited to)
the capabilities outlined in the <u>LEADS framework</u>
