Criterion 1: Supports quality of education. Eg: may help to strengthen student learning, curriculum delivery, assessment, teaching materials, accreditation or other processes, student supports, etc.

Criterion 2: Takes initiative and solves problems. Eg: anticipates needs, identifies problems, and suggests improvements, demonstrating creativity and resourcefulness.

Criterion 3: Upholds integrity and ethical conduct. Eg: holds high standards, is a dependable member of the team, shows responsible conduct, handles issues with sensitivity, etc.

Criterion 4: Shows innovation. Eg: in the development of tools, templates, approaches, technology, or other processes that improve education-related activities.

Criterion 5: Living our Values requirement: Demonstrates multiple CoM core values: accountability, belonging, collaboration, curiosity, and/or well-being.
