Must address all of the criteria:

Criterion 1: Exemplify learning, for example, through:

- a passion for discovery that contributes to proficiency in one's field
- a positive attitude toward, respect for, and trust in students and peers
- consideration of broad perspectives and worldviews

Criterion 2: Strive for excellence in teaching, for example, through:

- allowing for students to be inspired and engaged in authentic inquiry
- using instructional strategies and assessments that align with learning outcomes
- including learners in creating respectful and empowering spaces

Criterion 5: Living our Values requirement: Demonstrates multiple CoM core values: accountability, belonging, collaboration, curiosity, and/or well-being.

Criterion 3: Assess fairly, for example, through:

- designing assessments as learning, allowing students to self-assess
- designing assessments, which accompany opportunities for feedback
- designing assessments that align with course outcomes

Criterion 4: Enhance continuously, for example, through:

- reflecting on and enhancing teaching in response to feedback and learning outcomes
- engaging with other educators to share and learn from each other
