Criterion 3: Living our Values requirement: Demonstrates multiple CoM core values: accountability, belonging, collaboration, curiosity, and/or well-being.

Rate each criterion on a scale of 0-5; 0 = no evidence, 1 = minimal evidence, 2 = some evidence, 3 = moderate evidence, 4 = good evidence, 5 = very strong evidence
