# RISK FACTORS THAT MAKE IT MORE LIKELY YOUTH MAY HAVE TYPE 2 DIABETES

First Nations/Indigenous ethnicity

Parent or sibling with type 2 diabetes

Mom had diabetes during pregnancy

**Higher body weight** 

High blood pressure, high cholesterol, dark patchy skin in neck/groin

## WHO WAS INVOLVED IN THE PROJECT?



Onion Lake Health Team USask Study Team Eagleview Middle School

All grade 8 students participated in an education day.

If consent was received, they were screened for prediabetes/diabetes.

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### **EDUCATION DAY**



Students learned about diabetes, risk factors, healthy eating, & activity

### **ONION LAKE RESULTS**



1 in 5 positive for diabetes OR prediabetes

Diabetes = HgA1c 6.5% or higher Pre-Diabetes = HgA1c 6.0 to 6.4% No diabetes = Under 6%

#### **SCREENING DAY**



23 students were screened using dried blood spot test for HbA1c

#### **NEXT STEPS**

- Screen youth and refer them for follow-up
- Education to increase awareness of risk factors
- Programs/policies for healthy weight in children/youth (healthy eating, active living initiatives)
  (prenatal screening, healthy weight gain in pregnancy, breastfeeding)
