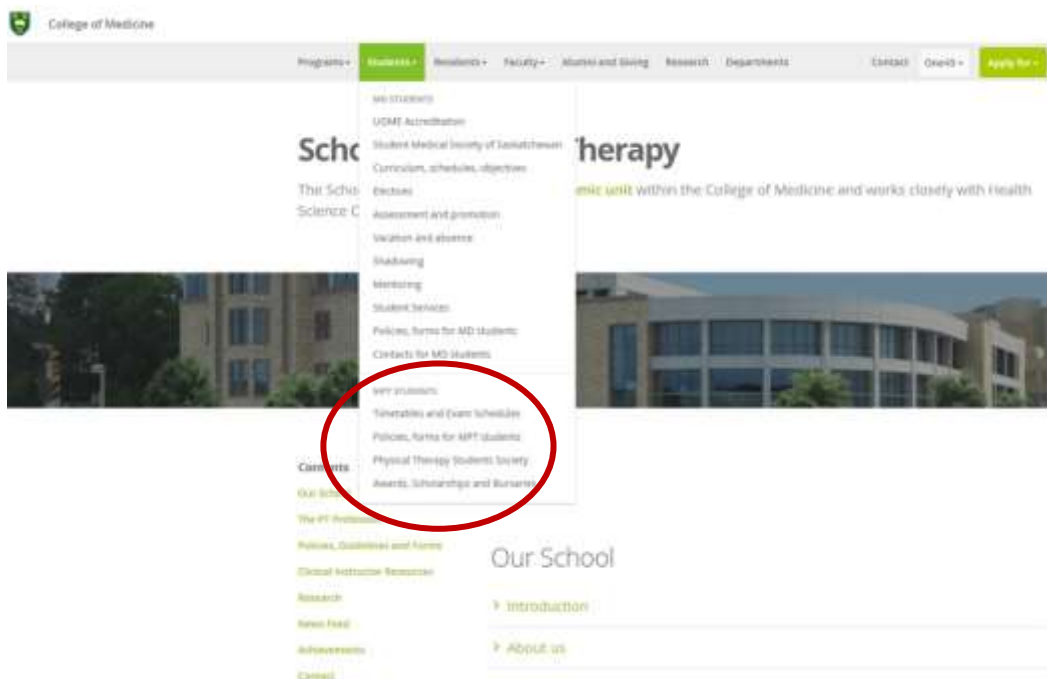


Orientation to the M.P.T. Student Policies

It is important for M.P.T. students to understand the policies, procedures and guidelines that apply to them or their academic program.




