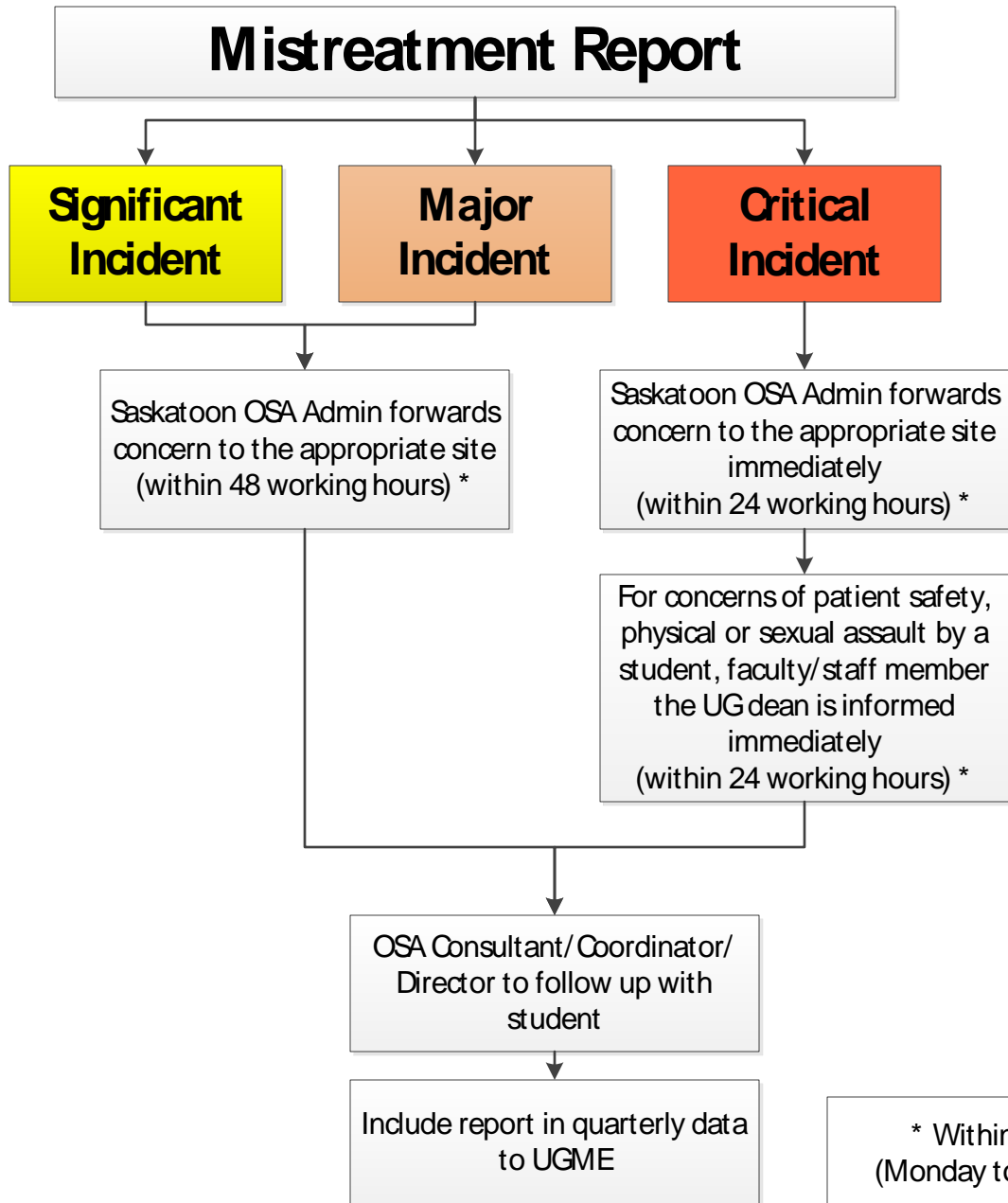

Significant Incident	Major Incident	Critical Incident
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Belittling, humiliating, or embarrassing comments - Offhand offensive, sexist, racist remarks/ names NOT directed at students/ patients - General rudeness/ lack of punctuality 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Repetitive belittlement/ humiliation/ embarrassment - Subjected to offensive, sexist, racist remarks/ names directed at students/ patients - Asked to perform personal services - Discrimination based on sexual orientation, gender, race, ethnicity - Subject to unwanted sexual advances 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Physically harmed - Sexual assault - Patient safety concern
