In 2021, in association with Mingling Minds, The Office of the Vice-Dean Research invested a total of **\$46,246.86** to catalyze collaborative, small-scale, time-sensitive research projects focused on COVID-19 vaccine roll-out, delivery, and impact in Saskatchewan. The 2021 Mingling Minds Rapid Response Funding Initiative (MMRRF) was able to provide seed funding for **5** novel, pilot research projects spearheaded by College of Medicine faculty.
