Criteria for Mingling Minds Membership

- *Academic Member*
 - o Active researcher or faculty eligible to apply for and hold research funds at the University of Saskatchewan
- *Affiliate Member*
 - o Any member who does not fall under the Academic or Student Member criteria
- *Student Member*
 - o Students registered in an undergraduate, graduate, or post-doctoral fellowship program who are under the (co-) supervision of a College of Medicine faculty

Academic Member Requirements

- Academic members are expected to attend at least one Mingling Minds event per academic term
- Collaborate with members, when possible, to facilitate interdisciplinary collaborations
- List Mingling Minds affiliation in manuscripts when appropriate
- List Mingling Minds membership in CV's
- Acknowledge Mingling Minds support on any OVDR funded research presentations or publications when appropriate
- Send in CV once a year for compilation

Mingling Minds has the right to revoke membership if an academic member does not meet the requirements above, or if an academic member does not exhibit professional behaviour and adhere to ethical standards.
