Dr. J. Mocco is a Professor and Vice Chair for Education in the Department of Neurosurgery at Icahn School of Medicine at Mount Sinai. Dr. Mocco is a cerebrovascular and endovascular neurosurgeon with clinical interests in stroke, brain aneurysms, subarachnoid hemorrhage, arteriovenous malformations, cavernous malformations, carotid artery stenosis, intracranial stenosis, and brain tumors. His research interests focus on translational efforts to treat ischemic and hemorrhagic stroke. He has published over 300 peer-reviewed publications, edited two textbooks on neurosurgical techniques, and runs numerous national and international clinical trials to improve the treatment of patients with cerebrovascular disease.
