Dr. Penny is a Canadian orthopaedic surgeon specializing in pediatric care. A Clinical Professor at the University of British Columbia, he teaches global surgery and serves on the Children's Health Foundation of Vancouver Island board. He trained in orthopaedics at the University of Alberta and Western Ontario, with fellowships in sports medicine and pediatric orthopaedics at Harvard and Nemours. Dr. Penny has extensive experience in international orthopaedics, including six years in Uganda, and consults globally on pediatric care in austere environments. He is an Overseas Fellow of COSECSA and a member of the Pediatric Orthopaedics Society of North America.
