Practical Perspectives on Health Leadership - From War Zones to Boardrooms

Stephan Plourde retired as a Colonel in the Canadian Armed Forces and was the Chief of Staff for the Canadian Forces Health Services. He led a variety of military healthcare organizations, both in care delivery as well as education and training, in Canada and abroad. As CEO Health Services Group East, Steve was recognized as a leader in the provision of health care to all Canadian Armed Forces Personnel in Ontario, Quebec and the Atlantic provinces, where he managed an integrated health system of military hospitals and clinics. Prior to retiring, Steve contributed to the military support to long-term care facilities in Ontario and Quebec during the initial months of the COVID-19 pandemic. Steve holds a Masters of Health Sciences from the University of Toronto where he was the recipient of the Robert Wood Johnson Award, selected by the faculty to the student most likely to make a noteworthy contribution in the field of health services administration. He was also decorated with the Meritorious Service Medal, given by the Governor General, for his role in leading a multi-disciplinary clinical mentorship team which focused on developing and implementing programs of instruction for the Afghan Armed Forces Academy of Medical Science.
