RE: Forge Ahead Fund

The Forge Ahead Fund is geared towards the early stages of development and demonstration on the research and development spectrum and cannot be used for basic or pure research. Generally projects are short term with clear deliverables that can be completed within six months to a year. Investigators will be expected to report their findings to the Industry Liaison Office.

The Forge Ahead Fund adds value to University of Saskatchewan developed technologies by eliminating some of the commercial uncertainties that normally surround a very early stage technology. The Industry Liaison Office anticipates that Forge Ahead funding will be used by Researchers as a stepping stone to external technology development programs.

Any Intellectual Property generated with this funding will be owned by the University of Saskatchewan. Funding under this program will accrue as a recoverable expense from future commercialization revenues.
