An important component of a CIHR grant application is the Project Biosketch. The Project Biosketch will be completed using the Canadian Common CV (CCV) interface, and will be used to assist peer-reviewers in determining whether an applicant has the necessary skills and experience required to conduct the proposed research described in the grant application. For that reason, all information placed in the Project Biosketch should be <u>directly relevant to the grant application</u>.

The Project Biosketch consists of seven sections:

- 1. Personal Information
- 2. Education
- 3. Recognitions
- 4. Employment
- 5. Research Funding History
- 6. Contributions i.e., Publications (up to 10), Intellectual Property (up to 5), Supervisory Activities (up to 5)
- 7. Knowledge and Technology Translation Activities (up to 5)
