Description:

The learner performs a complete and focused history and physical or mental status examination in a prioritized, organized manner, tailored to the clinical situation and specific patient encounter. The encounter is conducted with respect, in a manner sensitive to the patient's particular circumstances including sexual/gender orientation and cultural/religious beliefs.

The Entrustable learner

- Obtains the appropriate data from the patient (family/caregiver/advocate) for the specific patient encounter in a culturally safe manner
- Establishes a rapport with the patient (family/caregiver/advocate)
- Communicates intent and asks permission of the patient prior to examination, with consideration for personal, religious and cultural preferences
- Performs a physical exam or mental status exam appropriately tailored to the clinical case
- Demonstrates specific physical exam skills appropriate to the patient case.
- Integrates all these elements along with other sources of information
