MED ED RESEARCH TIPS

- Telemedicine / remote medicine in healthcare & medical curriculum.
- 1) As a qualitative researcher, first is to identify a problem that you want to solve. 2) Identify the research question and your objective. 3) Identify a methodology that you aim to achieve your goals/results. 4) Collaborate with other researchers to get ideas/ innovations for your research.
- The existing data in the clinical workflow instead of adding a new point of data collection.
- I like to make it less complex as possible. Use different method for data collection for flexibility and make my research rich.
- Do not rediscover the wheel. (Unless it adds value!! 😊).
- When critically analysing a paper, have students start by assuming it's wrong. The goal is to disprove that assumption.

TEACHING TIPS

- When teaching, start by taking a genuine interest in your trainees goals, then you can tailor your teaching to help them get there.
- Make teaching an interesting event by NOT pouring tons of info on students that's hard for them to digest it all.
- Finish class 5-10min early and invite discussion/ questions.
- Build a community of practice.
