

Community Reciprocity Fund

The Community Reciprocity Fund accepts applications from community-based initiatives, groups and organizations responding to the health needs of Saskatchewan communities. Up to \$2,500 is available for each initiative or activity.

This funding is intended to be flexible and responsive to the unique needs of each community. Special consideration is given to initiatives, groups and organizations working with vulnerable communities.

Eligible expenses include:

- Advocacy work
- Collaborative work with other community partners or university students/faculty
- Research, knowledge translation and evaluation
- Seed funding for project development or to leverage other, larger funds
- Support to engage people with lived-experience in planning and project initiatives
- Equipment and supplies needed for COVID-19 response

Who can Apply?

The Community Reciprocity Fund is open only to community-located partners. Applicants must be located in Saskatchewan. Groups do not need to be a registered charity or non-profit to apply for funding.
